Prayer outline from Matthew 6:9-13 (The Lord's Prayer)

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.	Begin with a time of worship and praise, honoring God for who He is.
Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.	Pray for specific needs and situations in your life, your families, and others that God will provide direction and that His will will be done.
	Pray for those who need salvation - God's ultimate will.
Give us this day our daily bread,	Thank God for his provision. Pray for the specific individual needs of friends and family. Pray for God's provision for the persecuted and for the poor.
	Pray for the bread of God's Word to be spoken to our hearts and the hearts of others. (The Word that we need and they need would be heard and received.) (Matthew 4:4)
	Allow for a time of silence, posturing your heart to hear from God, allowing Him to speak to you.
and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.	A time to search our hearts for sin and ask forgiveness and to search our hearts for those we need to forgive.
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.	Prayer for spiritual strength - overcoming sin in our lives and in other friends and family members and others God lays on your heart.
For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.	End with a time of worship and thanksgiving to God for His answers and provision and for who He is.
There is no "me" and "my" in the Lord's prayer, only "we" and "us."
